

BASIC COPYRIGHT PRINCIPLES



COPYRIGHT

It is the recognition that the Government makes in favor of all creators of literary and artistic works, by virtue of which it grants its protection so that the author enjoys exclusive privileges and prerogatives of a personal and patrimonial nature.

MORAL RIGHTS

Protect the author's non-economic interests, inalienable, imprescriptible, irrevocable and unteachable

PATRIMONIAL RIGHTS

It is the right for the author to receive financial compensation for the exploitation of his work. This right is in full force and effects the entire life of the author and 100 years after his death



LIMITATIONS TO PATRIMONIAL RIGHTS

- **I.** Quotation of texts, provided that the amount taken cannot be considered as a reproduction simulated and substantial content of the work;
- **II.** Reproduction of articles, photographs, illustrations and comments regarding current events, published by the press or broadcast on radio or television, or any other means of dissemination, if this has not been expressly prohibited by the right owner;
- III. Reproduction of parts of the work, for critic and scientific, literary or artistic research;
- **IV.** Reproduction for a only occasion, and in a single copy, of a literary or artistic work, for personal use and not for profit.



WHATIS PLAGIARISM?

Plagiarize is "copy in the substantial works of others, giving them as their own"


Copy a work and present it as your own, regardless of whether the copy is total or partial, it will not be relevant if much or little has been copied from it for plagiarism.

- Reproduce a text in a work without reference to its author.
- **Include phrases**, paragraphs or ideas of others in our writings, without citing their origin or author.
- Paraphrase a text or an idea, without citing its author.
- Present an own work already used: we talk about "auto plagiarism".
- Copy any multimedia work (audio, video, Webs), music, graphics, without citing the autor.



INTERNATIONAL CONTEXT
