



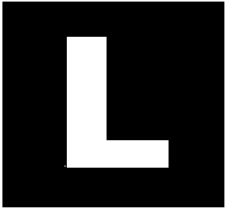

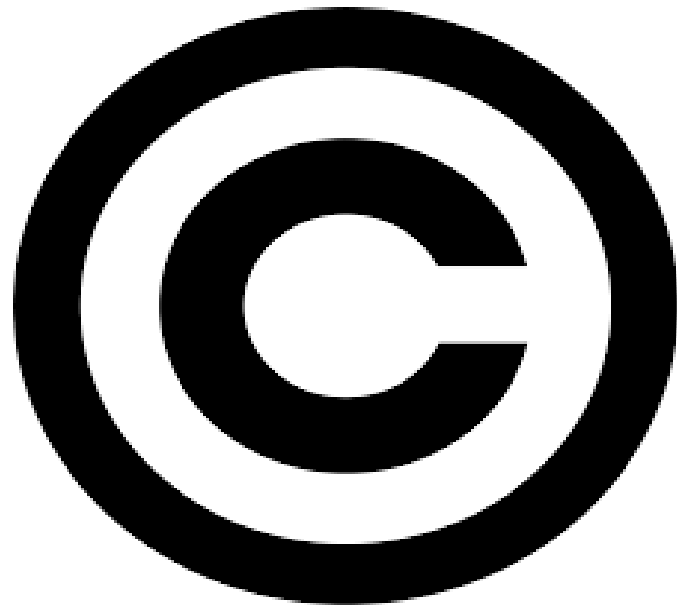
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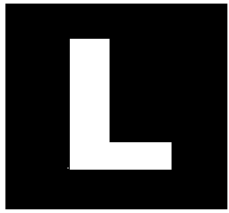

Plagiarize is *"copy in the substantial works of others, giving them as their own"*

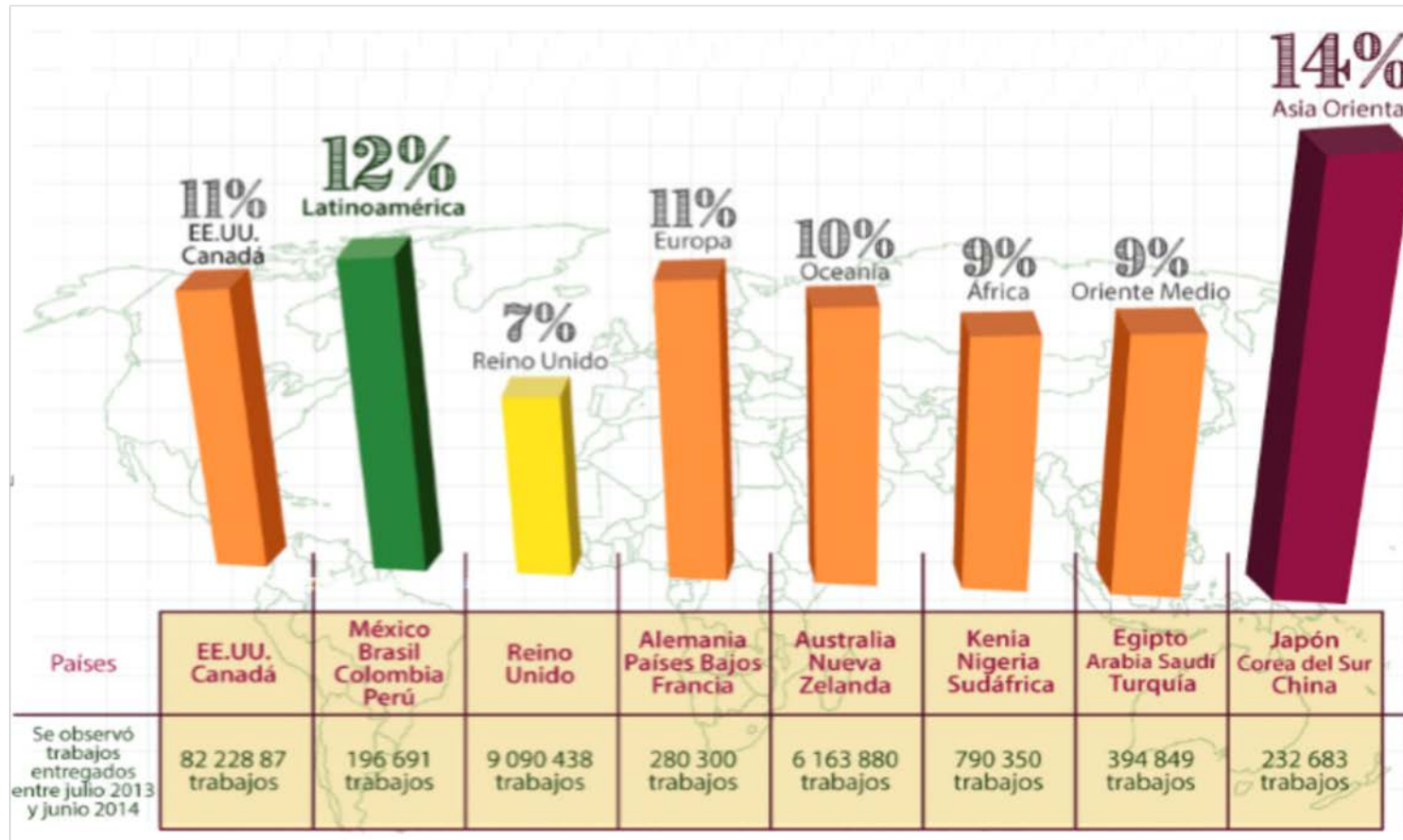
**Copy a work** and present it as your own, regardless of whether the copy is total or partial, it will not be relevant if much or little has been copied from it for plagiarism.

- **Reproduce a text** in a work without reference to its author.
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- **Copy any multimedia work** (audio, video, Webs), music, graphics, without citing the autor.
